### **Newt Gingrich to Headline Anniversary Dinner**

Former Speaker of the House Newt Gingrich will deliver the keynote address at the Nevada Policy Research Institute's 16<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner, the Institute announced. The event will be held at the Venetian Resort·Hotel·Casino in Las Vegas on Sept. 25, 2007.

Gingrich, who served as Speaker from 1995-1999, has remained a prominent figure in American politics since leaving office. He has authored numerous books on policy and historical fiction, and frequently appears on television and radio as a political analyst.

Gingrich has a PhD in Modern European History from Tulane University and taught history at West Georgia College in Carrollton, Georgia, in the 1970s before being elected to the House of Representatives, where he represented Georgia's sixth district from 1979-1999. In 1995, *Time* magazine named him its Man of the Year for his leading role in the Republican Party's takeover of the House.

"It is truly an honor for NPRI to have Newt Gingrich join us for our annual dinner," said NPRI president Sharon Rossie. "As one of the nation's preeminent minds on public policy, the Speaker will make a profound contribution to the success of the event."

Rossie said she expects tickets for the event to sell out quickly, due to the caliber of the keynote speaker as well as NPRI's continued growth and increasing influence as an organization.
