Rich Lowry to headline NPRI's annual dinner

The Nevada Policy Research Institute announced today that *National Review* editor Rich Lowry will deliver the keynote address at the Institute's 17th Anniversary Dinner, to be held on Sept. 23, 2008 at the Venetian Resort-Hotel-Casino in Las Vegas.

NPRI also announced it will honor Gov. Jim Gibbons at the event in recognition of his steps toward greater transparency in Nevada's government. The Institute's founder, Judy Cresanta, will be honored as well.

Lowry has served as the editor of *National Review*, the magazine founded in 1955 by the late William F. Buckley, Jr., since 1997. He is also a syndicated columnist, a commentator for FOX News, and the author of the *New York Times* bestseller *Legacy: Paying the Price for the Clinton Years*.

"Rich Lowry is among today's most talented and insightful commentators on current events, and we at NPRI are honored to have him deliver the keynote speech at our annual dinner," said NPRI President Sharon Rossie. "I have no doubt that his presence will go a long way toward making our event a tremendous success."

Previous keynote speakers at NPRI's annual dinner include former Speaker of the House Newt Gingrich, Col. Oliver North, Michael Reagan and former Colorado Gov. Bill Owens.
