## **NPRI to release report on government waste**

The Nevada Policy Research Institute will hold a press conference on Tuesday, September 23, 2008 to release a new report that documents some of the most egregious cases of wasteful spending in Nevada's state, county and city governments.

Joining NPRI in delivering remarks at the press conference will be State Sen. Bob Beers, one of the Nevada Legislature's most vocal critics of government waste, and David Williams, vice president for policy at Citizens Against Government Waste, which partnered with NPRI on the production of the report.

The report, titled "The Nevada Piglet Book 2008," was co-authored by Steven Miller, NPRI's vice president for policy, and Louis Dezseran, an NPRI researcher.
