Karl Rove to headline NPRI's annual dinner

The Nevada Policy Research Institute announced today that Karl Rove, former Deputy Chief of Staff and Senior Advisor to President George W. Bush, will deliver the keynote address at the Institute's 18th Anniversary Celebration, to be held on Sept. 23, 2009 at the Venetian Resort-Hotel-Casino in Las Vegas.

Rove is best known as "The Architect" of President Bush's two presidential campaigns. While at the White House, Rove oversaw the Offices of Strategic Initiatives, Political Affairs, Public Liaison, and Intergovernmental Affairs and coordinated the White House policymaking process as Deputy Chief of Staff for Policy. He is currently a *Wall Street Journal* and *Newsweek* columnist and Fox News contributor. He also has a book coming out in January 2010.

"Karl Rove has used his insider's experience and perspective to become one of today's most interesting and insightful commentators on politics and public policy. We at NPRI are honored to have him deliver the keynote speech at our annual dinner," said NPRI President Sharon Rossie.
