### **Steve Forbes to deliver keynote at NPRI dinner**

Steve Forbes, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Forbes Media, will deliver the keynote address at the Nevada Policy Research Institute's 19<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration, the Institute announced today. The event will be held on Sept. 30, 2010, at the Venetian Resort·Hotel·Casino in Las Vegas.

Forbes is the editor-in-chief of *Forbes* magazine and was a candidate for the Republican nomination for president in 1996 and 2000. Key components of Forbes' platform were a flat tax, medical savings accounts, a new Social Security system, parental school choice and term limits. Forbes continues to promote these ideas in his writings and in speaking engagements across the country.

"Steve Forbes is one of the nation's leading voices on behalf of limited government and free markets," said NPRI President Sharon Rossie. "From his stewardship of Forbes Media to his presidential campaigns, he has been and continues to be at the forefront of the effort to advance innovative, market-based ideas.
