Who May Apply

Any graduating high school student from Clark County, Nev., who will be pursuing a four-year degree program in Business, Economics, Political Science, Public Administration or a related field, at any accredited college or university may apply. Full-time and part-time employees of the Nevada Policy Research Institute, as well as children and dependents of NPRI employees, are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

Requirements

Applicants will be evaluated on the following:

- GPA: Applicants must have a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA
- Level of volunteer, community involvement and extra-curricular activities
- Content of a two-page essay addressing the following question:

Improving education: raise taxes or allow school choice?

Gov. Brian Sandoval has proposed raising taxes by \$1.3 billion to increase education funding. Do you support the governor's plan? Or, do you support improving education by introducing school choice programs — such as opportunity scholarships, online learning, charter schools, vouchers and education savings accounts — in Nevada?

• Income proof will be required if you are selected for this scholarship. Parents' combined Annual Gross Income, as shown in 2014 IRS Form 1040 line 22, should not exceed \$125,000.

Award

For year 2015, one scholarship in the amount of \$2,500 will be awarded with a check payable directly to the student.
