The alleged cybercrime risks posed by the disclosure of the requested information do not outweigh the benefits.

NPRI is entitled to attorney's fees and costs from PERS.

Any arguments of the parties not addressed in this order lack merit.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

The Petition for Writ of Mandamus is granted.

PERS is ordered to produce the following information to NPRI within five business days:

- a) Retiree name;
- b) Years of service credit;
- c) Gross pension benefit amount;
- d) Year of retirement; and
- e) Last employer

NPRI will file a memorandum of costs and an affidavit for attorney's fees that complies with FJDCR 15(13) within five business days.

Under NRS 239.052 PERS may charge a fee for providing a copy of the ordered public record. The fee must not exceed the actual cost to PERS to provide the copy of the public record.
