The Professor R.S. Nigam & Nevada Policy Freedom Scholarship

Any graduating high school student from Clark County, Nevada, who will be pursuing a four-year degree program in Business, Economics, Political Science, Public Administration or a related field, at any accredited college or university may apply. Full-time and part-time employees of the Nevada Policy Research Institute, as well as children and dependents of NPRI employees, are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

Requirements

Applicants will be evaluated on the following:

- GPA: Applicants must have a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA
- Level of volunteer, community involvement and extra-curricular activities
- Content of a one to two page essay addressing the following:
 - First, watch this video on who Milton and Rose Friedman are:

 - Second, pick an episode (included in the link below) to watch from the Free to Choose Network's re-published videos from Milton Friedman's original series

 - Then write a 1-2 page paper on the episode you chose, describing why that idea helps to promote personal and economic freedom.
- Income proof will be required if you are selected for this scholarship. Parents' combined Annual Gross Income, as shown in 2020 IRS Form 1040 Line 22, should not exceed \$125,000.

Deadline

All applications should include the 1-2 page essay as well as the 1 page application included here. Any application must be sent by June 15, 2021.
